

WATERFORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION
POSITION VACANCY
SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER

The Position:

The Waterford Township Board of Education is seeking qualified candidates to fill a vacancy on the Board. The Board, within the powers delegated to it by law, is the policy-making legislative branch of the School District. The term will run through December 2019. The position will be placed on the ballot at the annual election in November 2019, for a two-year term.

The minimum candidate qualifications are:

- A citizen of the United States of America
- At least 18 years of age
- A resident of Waterford Township for at least (1) year preceding the date of appointment
- Not directly/indirectly interested in a contract with a claim against the Board
- Not disqualified as a result of being a concurrent officeholder to another governmental elected position
- Registered to vote in the District and not disqualified from voting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
- Not disqualified as a result of a conviction of a crime or offense as listed in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1

The selected candidate shall be required to:

- Attend monthly public board of Education meetings.
- Vote on motions presented to the board.
- Attend committee meetings as assigned
- Submit an annual financial disclosure form.
- Comply with the School Board Code of Ethics, including completion of required training
- Undergo a criminal history background check upon appointment.

The Board of Education will review all qualifying applicants.

Interviews will be conducted on Wednesday, March 13, 2019. The board will select the candidate via majority board vote and the selected candidate will be sworn in following completion of the background check.
