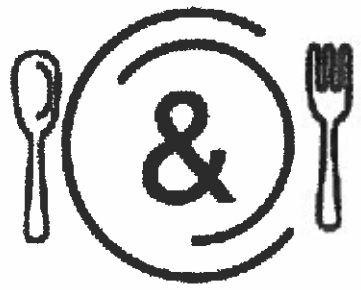

As educators, it is our goal to help children get the best possible education, while also helping them develop the skills, character traits and confidence to be successful in school. Our goal is to provide students with the support, encouragement and friendship of a non-judgmental therapy dog. Research indicates that a relationship with a therapy dog allows students to be more successful in school and in the community, and we believe this program will provide students with the enhanced support and encouragement they need to develop confidence and to achieve in school. Students will interact with the registered therapy dogs on a rotating building and classroom basis. Classroom visits will occur on Mondays throughout the school year.

We strongly believe that when a therapy dog, students, school personnel, and parents work together, it is a winning combination for children. Together, we can help students develop the skills they need to reach their goals. 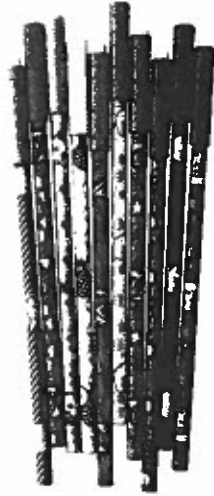
