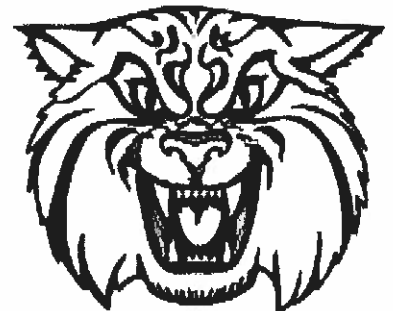

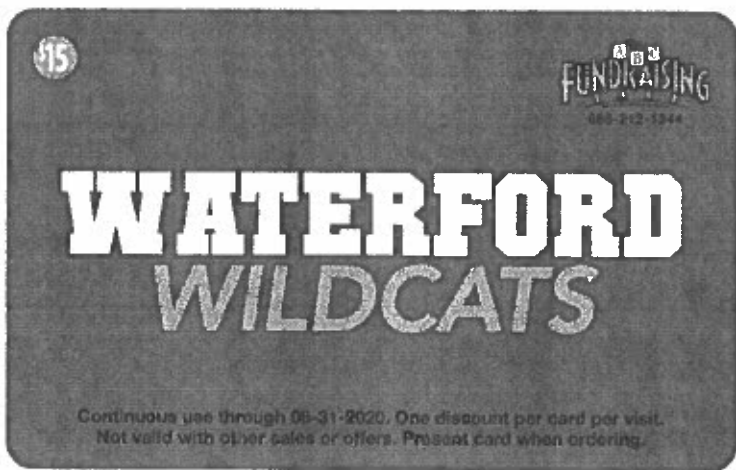

Trophies will be awarded at our Fire Prevention Expo- Friday, October 4th at our new Fire House at 2121 Auburn Avenue.

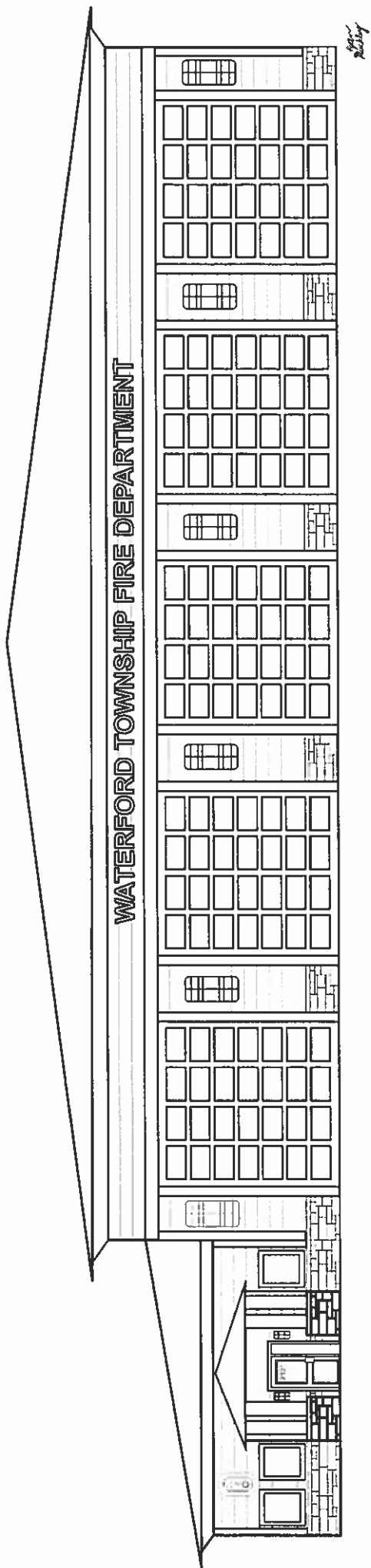
