

Immunization requirements for students entering preschool

Students entering preschool in the state of New Jersey must show proof of the following **mandatory** immunizations, as well as providing proof of a current physical exam before starting:

1. **DTap (Diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis):** 4 doses needed
2. **Inactivated Poliovirus (Polio):** 3 doses needed
3. **Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib):** at least one dose needed on or after 1st birthday
4. **Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV):** at least one dose needed on or after 1st birthday
5. **Measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR):** 1 dose needed
6. **Varicella (chickenpox):** 1 dose needed
7. **Flu shot is MANDATORY and must be received by 12/31 of the school year**

Students will not be allowed to begin the school year without proof of the mandatory immunizations and current physical.
